



Kids: Learn how to stay safe from fire and being burned!

- Matches and lighters are not toys, and you should never play with them. If you see matches or lighters, do not touch them and tell an adult right away.
- Do not touch or play with electrical outlets. They can be hot and shock or burn you.
- Only help cook meals or make snacks when an adult is present and watching you.
- Stay away from fireplaces and heaters which can get very hot quickly and can burn your skin even if you are just a few inches away.
- If your clothes catch on fire, STOP, DROP, and ROLL or if you use a wheelchair, LOCK, DROP, and ROLL.
- When you are trying to escape from a fire, never hide or run away from firefighters! Firefighters are there to help you and get you outside safely.
- Never go back inside a building on fire for anything, not even a pet or favorite toy. Get outside right away to your family's meeting place and stay outside until firefighters arrive.
