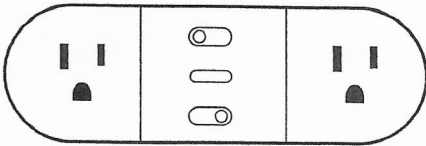

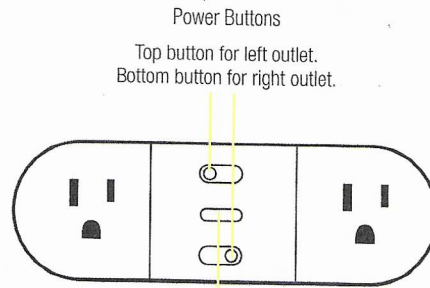

## Getting Started

### Download Safety 1st App

Download the **Safety 1st Connected** app by searching for Safety 1st in the app store.



### Setup

1. Plug the dual smart outlet into the wall outlet.
2. Check LED light on the dual smart outlet. It will rapidly flash blue.
3. Once paired, the LED light will turn blue and no longer flash.
4. Explore the features and functionality within the **Safety 1st Connected** app.

### Wi-Fi Connectivity

A 2.4 Ghz Wi-Fi internet connection is required.

Check the Wi-Fi signal strength from your router.

To **reduce signal interference or echoes**, avoid placing the dual smart outlet near major electrical appliances, large metal or concrete surfaces.
