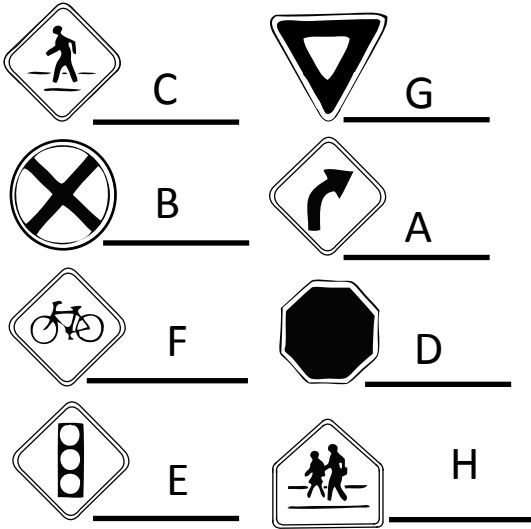

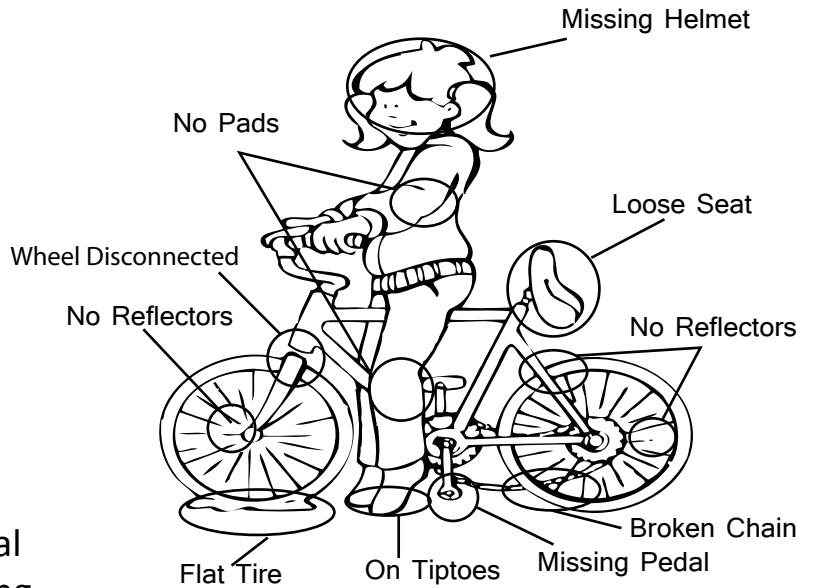


1. Match up the road signs to it's correct meaning from the list below.

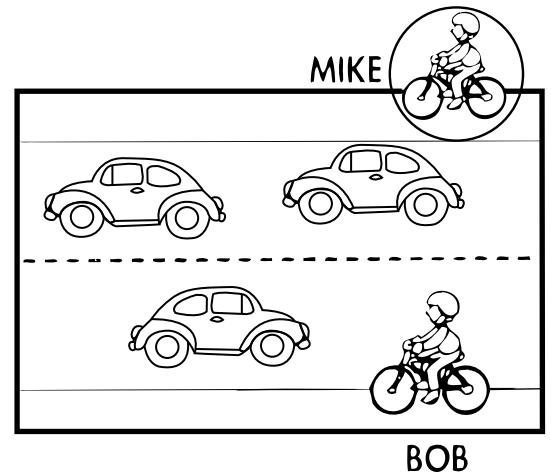

2. What's wrong with this picture? Circle the things that are wrong.

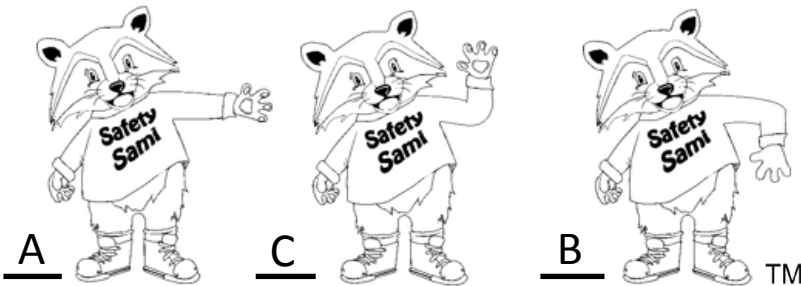


3. Circle the person that is riding his bike on the correct side of the street.
